**Range 1:** Small horses and ponies, such as Quarter Ponies, POAs and Hackney ponies

**Range 2:** Average-sized horses, such as Arabians, Morgans, Saddlebreds, Appaloosas and Standardbreds

**Range 3:** Larger horses, such as Quarter Horses, Hanoverians, Trekehners and Thoroughbreds

**Range 4:** Large warmbloods and draft horses, such as Holsteiners, Friesians and Clydesdales
